



INFORMED CONSENT FOR X-RAY

TO THE PATIENT: You have the right to be informed about your condition and the recommended surgical, medical, or diagnostic procedure to be used so that you may make the decision whether or not to undergo the procedure after knowing the risks and hazards involve. This disclosure is not meant to scare or alarm you. It is so that you may choose to give or withhold your consent to the procedure.

If you are pregnant or think that you may be pregnant, please inform the center personnel at once.

Your physician has requested that we perform an x-ray to obtain additional information. X-ray produces images of the internal body parts being examined. X-ray is painless, however, radiation is emitted. Therefore, it is critical for you to inform center personnel if there is any possibility you could be pregnant. Because the x-ray is a diagnostic procedure, it provides information that may aid your physician in diagnosing and treating your medical condition. Without the x-ray, accurate diagnosis and proper treatment may be delayed.

If you are having a fluoroscopic procedure, a contrast agent may be injected into your vein in order to produce better images of the part of your body that is being examined.

POTENTIAL RISKS – The following complications are possible anytime an injection is given, there is potential for pain, bleeding, bruising or swelling at the injection site. Exams requiring contrast may result in a mild headache, nausea, itching or other vague symptoms for a short time after the injection. Additional allergic reactions in response to the contrast agent may include hives, shortness of breath or difficulty swallowing. There have been rare instances of death after the administration of the contrast agent. It is very important to inform the technologist if you experience any of the conditions mentioned in this form.

NOTE TO PATIENTS: If you previously had a reaction to a contrast injection such as hives, severe itching, shortness of breath and/ or any significant reaction requiring hospitalization, a history of asthma, or other allergic conditions any history of anemia, sickle cell anemia, or kidney disorder, are pregnant or breast feeding you MUST inform the technologist.

There may be other imaging alternatives; however, your physician believes the x-ray to be the best diagnostic test for you, considering your symptoms and conditions. The benefit of this exam is to assist your physician with a diagnosis.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR OUR PATIENTS TO KNOW. PLEASE READ AND SIGN. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS, PLEASE ASK.

Mammography is the most sensitive screening test available to detect breast cancer, although; it has been proven to be able to reduce breast cancer mortality by at least one-third MAMMOGRAPHY IS NOT ACCURATE 100% OF THE TIME.

Some of the reasons breast cancers may be missed are:

1. **BREAST COMPOSITION** – The denser your breasts are the harder it is for mammography to detect masses. Denseness in the breast is the amount of fibrous and milk gland tissue relative to the amount of fat. Breasts tend to become less dense with age.

Texas H.B. 2012 – Henda’s Law states that the following information is to be conveyed (verbatim) by the mammography facility to each woman on completion of a mammogram in Texas:

If your mammogram demonstrates that you have dense breast tissue, which could hide abnormalities, and you have other risk factors for breast cancer that have been identified, you might benefit from supplemental screening test that may be suggested by your ordering physician.

Dense breast tissue, in and of itself, is a relatively common condition. Therefore, this information is not provided to cause undue concern, but rather to raise your awareness and to promote discussion with your physician regarding the presence of other risk factors, in addition to dense breast.

A report of your mammogram results will be sent to you and your physician. You should contact your physician if you have any questions or concerns regarding this report.

2. **COMPRESSION** – Compression is necessary for good mammography and to reduce the amount of radiation that you receive. If your breasts are so tender as to allow only mild compression accuracy maybe decreased.
3. **BREAST CANCER TYPE** – There are several types of breast cancer. Although many breast cancers can be detected when they are no bigger than a grain of sand, unfortunately, a few may grow very large and not produce any suspicious abnormality on the mammogram. Some cancers produce mammographic findings but are not suspicious initially. Finally, some breast cancers mimic non-cancerous abnormalities in every way, both mammographically and physically.
4. **IMPLANTS** – The presence of implants reduce mammographic accuracy, particularly if they are hard from scar formation. (RE: Rupture – The compression used for mammography could cause rupture of an implant. This is an unlikely event but the possibility is real, particularly for older implants whose walls have thinned. Only the amount of compression needed for diagnostic images will be applied, but no guarantee can be made concerning rupture. If you have any concerns have them addressed to your satisfaction prior to proceeding with mammography.)

Because neither mammography nor any medical test can be relied upon to detect all breast cancers, women are strongly encouraged to practice regular monthly breast self-examinations. Even if your examination today reveals nothing statistically suspicious, if you or your doctor remains concerned about any breast abnormality, or you become concerned after today, you are advised to have additional evaluation or to seek another opinion promptly.
